As you may or may not know by now, Governor Wolf has mandated that face masks be worn at all times when out in public at essential businesses in the state of Pennsylvania

We know that oftentimes Face masks can be a challenge to communication as it's hard to see the lip movements and facial expressions so to solve this issue, a wonderful team of volunteers is working with DHCC to sew together some clear masks to be distributed to the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Community

They are made from cloth and plastic and they are not FDA approved or medical grade.
